

# HOW THE SEGUE PROGRAM WORKS

## OBJECTIVE

Participating students receive 9 Student Career Exposures (SCEs) per year

## SCHOOL PROFILE

- 2,000 students (1,000 participate in Segue)
- 100 teachers (25 participate in Segue)
- 180 school days with 5 class periods per day

## SEGUE'S ROLE

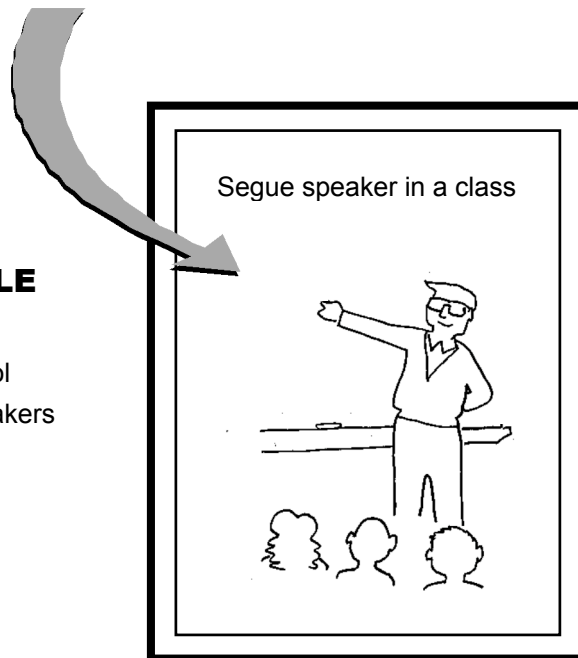
- Provide 100 speakers from the community's workforce
- Conduct Segue orientation for teachers and speakers
- Administer and maintain on-line self-scheduling system
- Measure outcomes for students, teachers, and speakers
- Provide next step options for students online

## THE TEACHER'S ROLE

- Individually choose to participate in Segue
- Sign-up on-line with Segue
- Select the number of Segue speakers per month
- Select the available class periods for speakers
- Provide 20 class minutes for each Segue speaker

## THE SCHOOL'S ROLE

- Provide class schedules
- Provide map of the school
- Provide an office for speakers to sign in



## THE SCE

SCE = Student Career Exposure

One SCE = One student exposed to one career option from one Segue speaker

The school receives 9,000 SCEs per year (100 speakers x 3 classes x 30 students).
